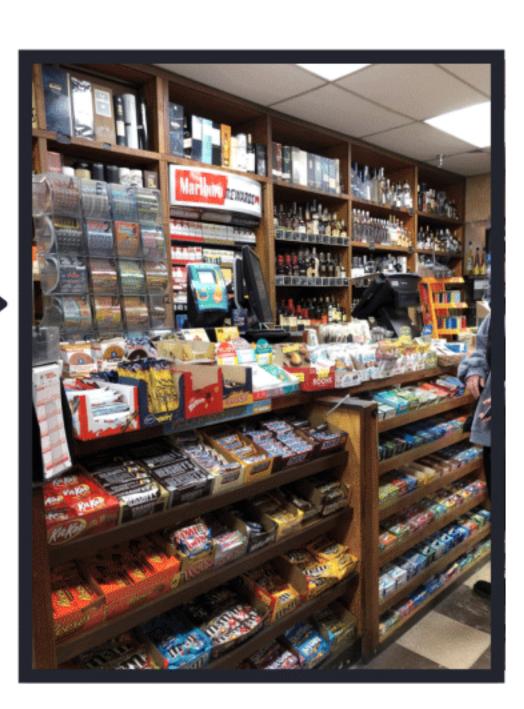
# **Tobacco in Our** Communities

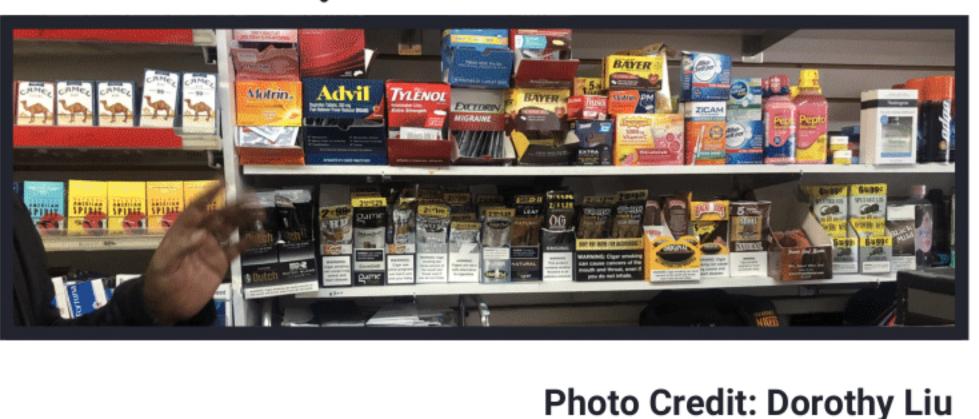
Tobacco has been deeply normalized in our communities so it is a challenging norm to reverse. Young people expect these products.

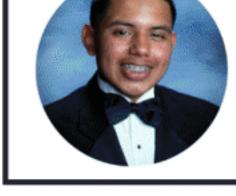

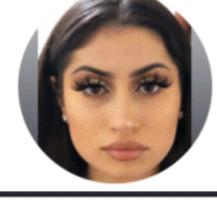
#### Who We Are
